The Client Bill of Rights:

Clients have the right:

- 1. To expect that a counselor has met the licensure or registration requirements of state law and rule;
- 2. To examine a counselor's licensing credentials;
- 3. To obtain a copy of the Code of Ethics of the Board of Counseling Professionals Licensure;
- 4. To file a complaint against a counselor with the board;
- 5. To be informed of the cost of professional services before receiving services;
- 6. To expect complete confidentiality except as required by law; and
- 7. To refuse any recommended services and to be advised of the consequences of this action.
- 8. The practice of counseling is regulated by the Board of Counseling Professionals Licensure. The board is authorized by law to discipline counselors who violate the board's law or rules. To learn about the complaint process, or to file a complaint against a counselor, contact
